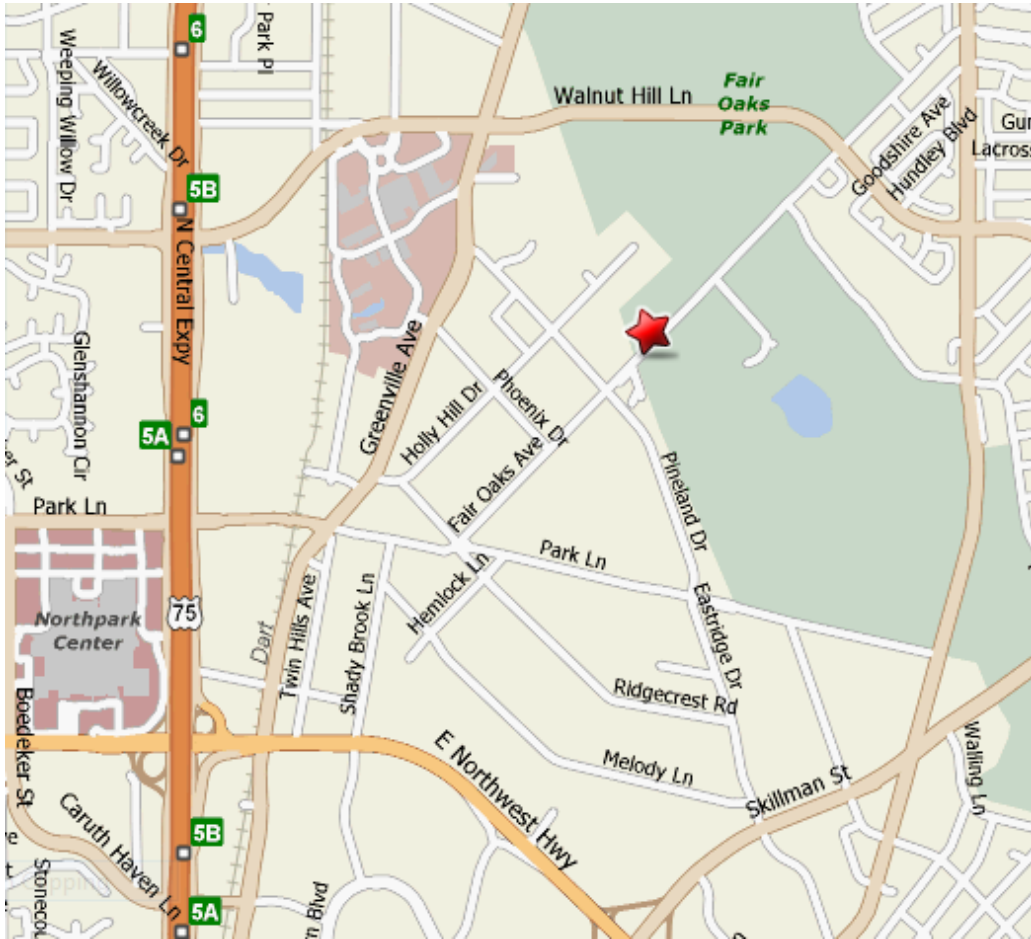

Frequently Asked Questions

How do the class levels work? Students take a full math SAT practice test at their 1st session. Based on their score, students are assigned to level 1, 2 or 3.

Level 1 concentrates on concept development. Level 2 covers concept development as needed, but mostly focuses on strategies, shortcuts and time management.

Level 3 is for students who already have high scores and are striving to get closer to the perfect 800 score. Level 3 concentrates on strategies, shortcuts and speed. All levels include strategies, shortcuts and speed.

Do I have to attend every class? No, you may attend whenever you can. Every session covers different material. However, the more classes you attend, the more likely your score will increase.
