Amount of Scholarship:

The scholarship committee will select ten seniors from the Dallas ISD graduating class of 2010 to receive a **\$20,000** scholarship upon documentation of enrollment in at least 9 credit hours in an accredited college/university/community college. Each semester the students must show proof of enrollment and maintain a 2.5 GPA or better. Each high school will submit at least two applications. The scholarship committee will make the final recommendation and select the ten recipients.

Application requirements must:

1. Have a minimum of 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
2. Have a financial need
3. Not be related to a Dallas ISD employee or to any member of the Board of Education
4. Submit two letters of recommendations
 - One from a teacher
 - One of your choice (i.e.: teacher, coach, pastor, co-worker, etc.)
5. Submit an official transcript (AAR)
6. Write a minimum of one page and maximum of two pages (double spaced) essay

Deadlines:

The student(s) must submit a completed application and all required information to the school counselor. Please, adhere to the following deadlines:

- **Submit to Counseling Services, School Administration Building, 3700 Ross Avenue, (room 208) by Friday, March 12th** (do not mail)
- Committee will read applications in April
- Campuses and winners will be notified by Friday, April 23rd
