Key Action Plan 1

Goal Statement

- Implement real-time student academic success tracking through incorporating the All In Learning web platform into the classroom on a daily basis through shared leadership. (Check For Understanding, Common Assessment, Weekly/Bi-Weekly Core Assessments).

Indicators of Success

- 100% of MW students will demonstrate growth on each Common Assessment by 70% December 12, 2014 and 75% of grade level by May 22, 2015.
- At least 80% of MW students in each grade level, K-5th, will pass all core Fall ACPs with a minimum of 70%.
- At least 80% of MW students in each grade level, K-5th, will pass all core Spring ACPs with a minimum of 70%.
- At least 80% of MW students in 3rd-5th grades will pass STAAR Reading, Math, and 5th grade Science tests.
- 100 % of MW teachers for 1st -5th grades will have implemented the web-based All In Learning system with clickers (3rd -5th initially; 1st & 2nd will phase in clickers) in the classroom to monitor real-time student academic success on given SLOs by December 2014.



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Leader Actions

- Create an All In Learning (AIL) committee, consisting of each grade level chair (K-5) by August 29, 2014.
- Collaborating with the AIL committee, will develop a calendar to include intervention strategies for targeted SLOs per core per grade level, implementation of specific SLO assessments (Q&A, CFU, weekly, bi-weekly, unit exam, and common assessments), follow-up dates with data, and develop trend-spotting for mastered and non-mastered SLOs.
- Upload all MW students and teachers into the AIL web-based system,
- Provide professional development for AIL web-based system, which will be ongoing as needed in both individual and group settings.
- Provide teacher accounts for each teacher from Kinder-5th grade to login and access ALL web-based platform.
- Provide each teacher with AIL documentation
- With AIL committee members, create a system of Check For Understanding and other assessments directly related to ACP (Fall and Spring) and STAAR assessments.
- Conduct monthly surveys (Fall Semester only; quarterly surveys starting the spring semester) for teacher feedback and review with AIL committee members to monitor the implementation of the daily/weekly SLO success tracking and make revisions accordingly. (Fall- Sept, Oct, Nov., Dec. (toward the end of the month); Spring- Feb/Mar.2015, Apr./May 2015).
- Recognize pockets of excellence (teacher) in implementing AIL and provide an incentive (at the end of every 6 weeks, 2 per six weeks).
- Provide appropriate support to AIL committee members to become “experts” and a resource person for their grade level by the end of the first semester.
- Provide appropriate support for AIL committee member/s to present professional development for staff on specific every 6 weeks.



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Staff Actions

- 100% of MW Kinder-5th grade teachers will participate in weekly discussions to discuss ALL web-based platform.
- 100% of MW Kinder -5th grade teachers will implement ALL daily, weekly, and triweekly and provide data on the appropriate report/forms to be utilized in weekly grade level meetings.
- 100% of MW Kinder-5th grade teachers will utilize the reports feature of ALL to determine each students' instructional need and design an appropriate method to improve their area/s of weakness and strength for enrichment.
- 100% of MW Kinder-5th grade teachers will plan, participate, and attend "MW Family Math Night", date TBA. Each grade level will have a minimum of 3 engaging activities that parents can play and take home to support their student to improve their mathematical and problem-solving skills.
- 100% of MW Kinder-5th grade teachers will have ALL protocols implemented into the classroom instruction by December 2014.
- 80% of MW Kinder-5th grade teachers will rate proficient on ALL implementation rubric by December 2014.; 100% will have reached proficiency by March 2015.
- 100% of MW Kinder-5th grade teachers will have ALL by usage documentation (Admin View) beginning with the week of September 8, 2014.



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Professional Development

- **Based on ALL calendar developed by the AIL committee and the campus needs, changes may occur.**
- ALL initial professional development will be provided by the Instructional Coach.
- Additional professional development by IC will include updates, news, and other technology resources.
- ALL professional development will be provided by ALL committee member/s as needed including sharing various ways of implementing AIL in the classroom.
- Weekly collaborative discussions to discuss AIL.

Funding

- ALL license and a class set of clickers for each classroom in grade levels 1st -5th.
