 - b. Adaptability/Flexibility/Collaboration/Well Rounded Curriculum/Open Space
 - c. Keep in mind the unique culture of DeGolyer and STEAM.
 - i. The Parents are really involved with the school and are seeking out best/well rounded education.
 - ii. Parents supporting the school and the children through the PTA and Dad's Club.
 - iii. Diverse Community (There are a lot of community-based events)
 - d. Allow for the students to be independent and experience things they might encounter when they reach college, so that they are better prepared for the future.
 - e. Maker Spaces & adaptable classrooms, School will need an Autism Unit – Sensory Room
 - f. Mural/Art Projects were also a big focus for the community – Community Collaboration.
 - g. Lots of Color/Motivational/warm inviting – a fun place to be. Have an emphasis on visual stimulation.
 - h. Provide storage space for PTA and Dad's club.

- i. Provide a community garden as part of the school, team should locate so that neighborhood can access when school is out of session.
- j. Design for a secure school. Vestibules are No. 1 Priority.
- k. Council member Flores stated the proposed school should be "right sized" for the streets and neighborhood.
- l. Welcoming – reflect generationally the community.
