



WHAT IS A CHARETTE?

A charette is an intensive planning session where staff, parents, and community stakeholders work with architects, designers, and program managers to create a vision for renovations and replacement of our schools. It provides a forum for creative ideas and provides both immediate and ongoing feedback loops between designers, stakeholders, and the community. More importantly, it allows everyone who participates to be a mutual author of the plan for the campus. These online charrettes maintain a high level of engagement, idea generation, and feedback with school staff, parents, community residents, stakeholders, and the general public that is so critical to creating a successful design and construction plan. Meetings, presentations, and interactive design sessions will be held through a combination of online platforms.
