<b>Pants, skirts, jumpers, shorts, capris</b>	<p><b>Color:</b> All Pk-8 students must wear solid Khaki. Girls may wear bike or dance shorts underneath their skirts or jumpers.</p>						
<b>Jackets, cardigans, and sweaters</b>	<p>All jackets may be solid navy with no wording.</p>						
<b>Footwear</b>	<p><b>Style:</b> If your child cannot tie his/her shoe, please have your child wear shoes with velcro straps. Students in grades PK-2 must wear closed toed/closed heel shoes. Students in grades 3-8 may wear athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes, or open toed/open heeled shoes.</p>						
<b>Hats, caps, bandanas, sweatbands</b>	<p><b>These items are not to be worn on campus.</b></p>						
<b>Socks, Leggings</b>	<p><b>Style:</b> Socks and leggings can be any color.</p>						
<b>Consequences for Dress Code Violators</b>							
<b>1<sup>st</sup> Offense</b>	<p>Parent phone call to bring a change of clothes or visit the clothing closet to borrow a shirt/pants  Warning letter is sent home.</p>						
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense</b>	<p>Parent phone call to bring a change of clothes or visit the clothing closet to borrow a shirt/pants  Warning letter is sent home. Middle school students will receive after-school detention.</p>
