South Oak Cliff High School provides computer use, including Internet access, to students in order to further the educational aims of the school. Access is given as a privilege, not a right, and may be limited or denied by school personnel.

Terms and Conditions you agree to as a South Oak Cliff High School Student

1. I understand that...

- a. computer use that disrupts the educational environment is not permitted.
- b. anything I do on SOC High computers, or on the SOC network is not private and can be monitored by district faculty and staff.

2. I will not ...

- a. change any computer setting on the computers or netbooks.
- b. access Twitter, Facebook, checking personal email or use instant messenger on the library computers or netbooks.
- c. use anyone else's ID and password nor allow anyone else to use my username or password.
- d. Download or store on the library computer or netbook any music, games, videos or other media.

3. I assume responsibility for...

- a. any damages to school equipment while I am using it. This includes paying for repairs.

I understand and will abide by the Acceptable Use Policy. I will be responsible for the consequences of inappropriate use of technology, including the Internet. I understand that consequences may include revocation of privileges of access to the Internet and/or other technological resources, suspension, expulsion, and possible legal action.
