IB Diploma Programme Requirements

1. Students are enrolled in one course from each of the six subject groups.
 - a. Students take at least three courses at the higher level (no more than four) and three courses at the standard level (or two courses if enrolled in four HL courses)
 - b. Please note: Students at WWHS, take four SL classes during year 1 (Junior Year) and choose their third HL at the end of the academic year going into year 2 (Senior Year). This provides students with an opportunity to participate in their standard level classes and determine their third HL subject and meet the subject requirements for the IB Diploma.
2. Students must complete: The Core requirements (Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE), and Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS)).
 - a. EE & CAS are completed externally with the support of an advisor.

Achieving the IB Diploma

- Along with subject enrollment requirements all assessment components for each of the six subjects and the additional Diploma requirements must be completed in order to qualify for the award of the IB diploma.

The IB Diploma will be awarded to a candidate provided ALL of the following requirements have been met.

1. The candidate has earned **24 points**.
2. The candidate earns at least **12 points on HL subjects** (or the highest three HL grades for those who have 4 HL courses).
3. The candidate earns at least **9 points on SL subjects** (candidates who register for two SL subjects must earn at least 5 points).
4. There is **no** grade 1 awarded in a subject/level.
5. There are **no more than two grade 2s** awarded (HL or SL).
6. There are **no more than three grade 3s** or below awarded (HL or SL).
7. All CAS requirements have been met.
8. There is no "N" awarded for TOK, the EE, or a contributing subject.
9. There is no grade "E" awarded for TOK and/or the EE.
10. The final award committee has not given the candidate a penalty for academic misconduct.
